SCHOOL BANKING

Well done to everyone for Term 2 School Banking. Term 2 has seen some amazing rewards go out to our super savers such as, Secret Scratch Pads, Handballs, Glow lights and Sparkle Glitter Pens. We have also seen some of our School Bankers receive their Bronze Certificate.

School Banking is also a great fundraiser for our school. Our school receives a Regular Savers Contribution of \$5 for every 10 deposits processed per student as well as an Annual Contribution which is based on the number of students who made at least one School Banking deposit in the prior year. For Term 1 2018, Upper Orara school has received \$132 in fundraising contributions from the Commonwealth Bank School Banking Programme. These donations benefit the school, students and their families to help go towards resources, equipment and lowering costs for things like excursions, events and travel. So, a big thank you to all our School Bankers and the Commonwealth Bank School Banking Program as these contributions are greatly appreciated by our school.
