We look forward to seeing many families at the numerous events and activities taking place over the coming weeks.



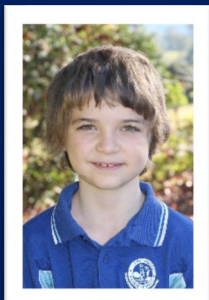

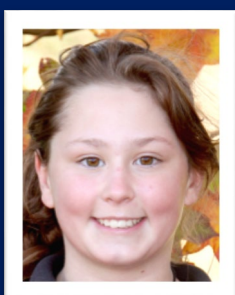

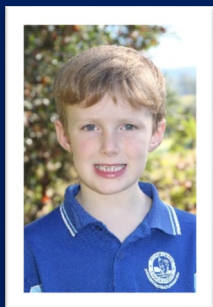
