For these sessions your child will also need to bring a hat, wear enclosed shoes and clothing that covers the shoulders.







A Quick Guide to Road **Rules in School Zones** 

HELPING OUR KIDS STAY SAFE IN SCHOOL ZONES

Driving in school zones is a serious responsibility and here's how to stay aware to make sure you're following the road rules.



SCHOOL

ZONE

#### **NO STOPPING**

No Stopping at all on any length of road to which a No Stopping sign applies.

**FINE \$410**° **DEMERIT POINTS 2** 



ZONE

#### **BUS ZONE**

You are not allowed to stop vour vehicle in a Bus Zone at all. Only public buses can stop here.

**FINE \$410 DEMERIT POINTS 2** 



#### **NO PARKING**

You are not allowed to park here at all. You can only stop dropping off or picking up passengers. You must stay within 3 metres of your vehicle for no longer than 2 minutes.

**FINE \$227 DEMERIT POINTS 2**

NO DOUBLE PARKING

Double Parking is not allowed. You must

not stop on a road between the centre

of the road and another parked car.



#### SCHOOL DAYS

8 - 930 AM

230 - 4 PM

DO NOT SPEED Between the hours of 8-9.30am and 2.30-4pm on school days the speed limit is 40km per hour.

Fines and demerit points in school zones have been increased.

Make sure you always stay within 40km speed limit in school zones.

MAX \* FINE \$4643 \* MAX DEMERIT POINTS 7

^ Maximum penalty fine and demerit points for a class A motor vehicle Exceeding speed over 45 km/h in a (school zone).

#### **NO MOBILE PHONE USE**

Do NOT use a hand held mobile at any time while driving.
